

**Warren County Commissioners Public Hearing**

Commissioner Tricia Durbin called the meeting of the Warren County Commissioners Public Hearing to order with Commissioner Jeff Eggleston present.

Commissioner Tricia Durbin called the meeting to order stating that the meeting is being recorded.

Projects proposed utilizing 2021 CDBG funds are:

\$ 110,442.00 Replacement of the undersized, and thus inadequate, storm water sewer on Center Street, between Brown Ave and Railroad Street, in Clarendon Borough. This project will serve 19 households.

\$ 93,356.00 Engineering/Design and Construction of a new Municipal Water Line Extension on High Street in Sheffield Township. This new water line will replace the existing spring fed water system to the 11 households on High Street.

\$ 44,736.00 CDBG Program Administration

Lorri went onto state that as of late yesterday, Sheffield has pulled their project. Not all residents were in agreement with this project, and they do not want to force anyone to hook up.


Once we find another project, we will need to hold another public hearing.
