Commissioner Benjamin Kafferlin called the meeting of the Warren County Commissioners Public Hearing to order with Commissioner Tricia Durbin and present by phone was Commissioner Jeff Eggleston

Commissioner Benjamin Kafferlin called the meeting to order stating that the meeting is being recorded.

Commissioner Benjamin Kafferlin stated that today we are here to hear the intended uses of the 2021 CDBG funds and receive any public comment. He then turned the hearing over to Lorri Dunlap, Grants Administrator.

Lorri Dunlap stated that for 2021 the county will receive \$248,534.00 in CDBG funds.

Lorri went on to state that at least 70% of the available funding must be used for activities which benefit low and moderate-income persons. The proposed activities must benefit at least 51% low-moderate income persons in the service area to qualify as a low-moderate income project.

Projects proposed utilizing 2021 CDBG funds are:


\$ 110,442.00	Replacement of the undersized, and thus inadequate, storm water sewer on Center Street, between Brown Ave and Railroad Street, in Clarendon Borough. This project will serve 19 households.
\$ 93,356.00	Reconstruction of Center Street in Bear Lake Borough. This project will serve 10 households.
\$ 44,736.00	CDBG Program Administration

Lorri stated that program administration covers part of her salary, advertising, travel etc.

Commissioner Benjamin Kafferlin asked if there were any comments from the public to which there were none.

With nothing further, this public hearing was closed at 12:04.
