**A RESOLUTION OF THE WARREN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, WARREN COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING A LABOR STANDARDS ADMINISTRATOR FOR
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROJECTS.**

WHEREAS, Warren County has been awarded funding through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG program requires that certain labor standards, including the payment of prevailing wages, be adhered to by contractors and subcontractors working on federally funded projects, in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act and other applicable labor laws; and

WHEREAS, Warren County recognizes the importance of ensuring full compliance with these labor standards to protect workers and maintain the integrity of the CDBG program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Warren County Commissioners:

1. The Warren County Commissioners hereby appoint Josh Cotton, CDBG program administrator, as the Labor Standards Administrator for all CDBG-funded projects managed by Warren County, effective immediately.
2. The Labor Standards Administrator will be responsible for overseeing and ensuring compliance with labor standards for all contractors and subcontractors involved in the CDBG project, including but not limited to:
 - a. Ensuring payment of prevailing wages in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act.
 - b. Monitoring payroll records for accuracy and compliance with wage rates.
 - c. Ensuring that all required labor standards notices are posted on the job site.
 - d. Assisting in resolving any complaints or disputes related to labor standards.
3. The Labor Standards Administrator is authorized to take all necessary actions to enforce these standards, including conducting periodic site visits, reviewing payroll documentation, and providing guidance to contractors as needed.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.


