**A RESOLUTION OF THE WARREN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, WARREN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ADOPTING A DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE POLICY FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDED ACTIVITIES.**

**WHEREAS**, Warren County has received funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

**WHEREAS**, the Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988 (Public Law 100-690) mandates that all federal grant recipients maintain a drug-free workplace as a condition for receiving federal funds; and

**WHEREAS**, Warren County is committed to ensuring a safe, productive, and drug-free work environment for all employees and contractors involved in CDBG-funded activities; and

**WHEREAS**, Warren County desires to implement a policy to comply with the requirements of the Drug-Free Workplace Act and to prevent the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession, or use of a controlled substance in the workplace;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Warren County Commissioners:

1. Warren County hereby adopts the Drug-Free Workplace Policy for all employees, contractors, and subrecipients working on activities funded by CDBG, in accordance with the Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.


