

Resolution #3319

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF WARREN, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE COMMONWEALTH FINANCING AUTHORITY FOR LOCAL SHARE ACCOUNT (LSA) FUNDING AND COMMITTING FIFTY PERCENT (50%) MATCHING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the County of Warren desires to apply to the Commonwealth Financing Authority for a grant from the Local Share Account (LSA) Program to fund the replacement of a sheriff patrol vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Warren County recognize the importance of this project to the community and wish to commit local financial resources toward its completion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Warren County hereby authorizes submission of an application to the Commonwealth Financing Authority for LSA funding in the amount of \$31,056.47 for the Warren County Sheriff's Office Patrol Vehicle Replacement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of Warren hereby commits to providing a fifty percent (50%) match toward the total project cost, totaling \$32,262.92; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Warren County Chief Clerk and the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners are authorized to execute all documents and agreements necessary to complete the grant application and to administer the grant upon award.


